Springwater Sports Heritage is a non-profit organization governed by a Board of volunteers composed of nine (9) Directors and two (2) ex officio members. The Board provides leadership, governance, succession planning, operational and strategic accountability within its codified constitution and an established operational relationship with the Township of Springwater.

The purpose of Springwater Sports Heritage is:

- A) To digitally chronicle, preserve and provide internet access to Springwater's sports heritage and
- B) To ceremoniously acknowledge and exhibit the awards of exceptional sporting contributions and achievements of Springwater's Athletes, Builders and Teams.

The Board has established an internet-based archive to accommodate and accumulate the memorable Sports Heritage of our Township. To enhance access and the preservation of Springwater's sports heritage we are amassing a digital archive of documents, memorabilia and recordings. The internet-based platform approach provides a foundation for enormous development, storage and securing of Springwater's valuable sports related history.
